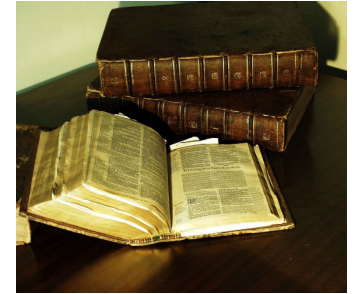

# Dispensational Truth and Daily Living

## Introduction

- A Christian who ignores dispensational distinctions is likely to go wrong in practical life
- Here are some examples:
  - Law keeping
  - Worship
    - Addressing Christ
    - Use of OT Psalms
  - Christian giving (not 'tithing')

# Dispensational Truth and Daily Living

## Law Keeping



- Is the Law sin? – Rom 7v7 – No
- What is the Law? – Rom 7v12
- Schoolmaster unto Christ – Galatians 3v24
- Showed what sin is – Rom 7v7
- Fulfilled in us – Rom 8v4
- We are “not under law but under grace” (Rom. 6:14)

# Dispensational Truth and Daily Living

## Is Jesus my king?



- Is Jesus king now? – Luke 19v14
- Will Jesus be king? – 1 Cor 15v25
- We shall also reign with Him – 2 Tim 2v12
- The Corinthians got this wrong. They were a dispensation ahead: “ye have reigned without us!” 1 Cor. 4:8



# Dispensational Truth and Daily Living

## Tithes

- Abram gave tithes to Melchizedek: tithes of all – Gen 14v20
- Jacob to God – Gen 28v22
- Tithes of land, tree and beast – Lev 27v32

- How much did the Lord give?
  - 10%, 20%, 40% or 50% ?
  - 100% !
  - Gal 2v20 -- “gave himself”
  - Matt 13v44 – “all that he hath”
- Who are we following?
  - Jacob
  - Moses
  - The Lord
- Nothing less than 100% is right for the Christian



# Dispensational Truth and Daily Living

## The Psalms

What are the Psalms? → Jewish Hymn Book

When used?

- Godly in time of trouble (102)
- Going up to the feasts (120-134)
- Time of joy and thanksgiving (136)

How had God revealed himself?

- To Abraham as the Almighty
- To Moses and the Children of Israel as Jehovah – the covenant keeping God – Ex 6v3
- To the Church as the “Father”

- The Revelation of God as Father is the highest truth.
  - Heb 1v1-2
  - John 1v18
  - John 4v23
- True Christian worship is to the Father, as God was not revealed as Father till the coming of His Son.
- The Psalms cannot be used for Christian Worship.
